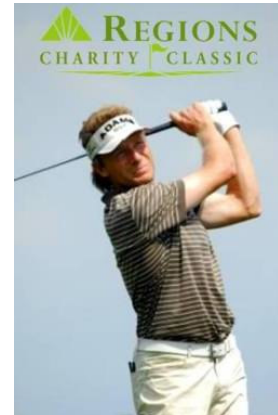


## Tournament Updates
